Course in Firearms and Weapons
Safety (Approved for Licensing in
Queensland)

DESCRIPTION

This course meets the requirement in Queensland under the Weapons Act 1990 that license applicants complete a course approved by the Commissioner of Police in firearms/weapons safety training.

It prepares Weapons Act license applicants who may be deemed to be fit and proper persons and with genuine reasons under the Weapons Act 1990 with the knowledge and applied skills to possess and use firearms/weapons lawfully, responsibly and safely so making them eligible to obtain Qld Weapons Act licenses in one or more of the following categories of firearms/weapons based on the genuine needs of the individual:

Category General Descriptions: A - Rimfire Rifles, Break/Bolt Action Shotguns, Paintball, Air rifles / B - Bolt/Break/Pump/Lever Action Centrefire Rifles / C - 5 Round Pump/Semi Auto Shotguns, 10 Round Semi Auto Rimfire H - Handguns/Pistols / D - Semi Automatic Centrefire Rifles, Pump/Lever/Semi Auto Shotguns over 5 Rounds & Semi Auto Rimfire over 10 Rounds / M - Miscellaneous (Collectors) / M - Miscellaneous (Crossbow) * Refer to legislation for Category Specific details. * Individual Genuine reason required for each category

The course also provides necessary firearms/weapons safety training for Queensland Police Service staff, who as part of their duties require the physical possession of firearms/weapons / Officers in other government departments (government service entities) who possess and use firearms/weapons as part of their normal duties including seed gathering and animal tagging, euthanizing and culling / Queensland Weapons License applicants (Sports & Target Shooting / Recreational Shooting / Occupational genuine reasons (* Category Specific)

OVERVIEW

This course is delivered in a face-to-face workshop format incorporating knowledge-based theory assessment and range practical assessment activities conducted over a day period depending on the knowledge skill and competency of participants and meeting mandated legislative competency requirements.

PREREQUISITE UNITS

Must be:

- Over 11 Years of age
- A fit and proper person and not excluded from holding a Weapons (Firearms) License under State/Territory Legislation

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Photo ID, Statement of Eligibility against State/Territory Legislation. It is essential that participants have year 10 literacy and numeracy skills or the equivalent. These entry requirements are necessary to show the applicant is able to read and interpret the legislative requirements and firearms safety standard applicable to weapons (firearms) licensing.
