



AHC30324 Certificate III in Rural and Environmental Pest Management (Pest Animal Controller)

DESCRIPTION

This qualification describes the skills and knowledge required for pest management contractors, pest management field officers, vertebrate pest management field officers and weed management field officers in the pest management industry.

The qualification covers those who work in weed management as well as vertebrate pest management in conservation, land management, horticulture and agriculture settings.

Individuals in these roles work under general direction and participate in strategic invasive species management practices, prepare for management programs, complete and assess management programs, carry out weed management programs that require chemical spraying, maintain required records. State or territory licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply in some jurisdiction. This course is an entry level Environmental Pest Management Qualification encompassing numerous hands-on industry specific, field orientated practical activities.

Licensing and Legislative outcomes may link to specific units in this qualification depending on stream and units chosen under available packaging rule options.

OVERVIEW

This course is delivered in a face to face workshop and industry field placement format incorporating knowledge-based theory assessment and field practical assessment activities conducted over a day depending on the knowledge skill and competency of participants.
