DESCRIPTION

This qualification describes the skills and knowledge required forpest management contractors, pest management field officers, vertebrate pest management field officers and weed management field officers in the pest management industry.

The qualification covers those who work in weed management as well as vertebrate pest management in conservation, land management, horticulture, and agriculture settings. The qualification provides for work roles encompassing a broad range of skills, or can be focused on one or more specialisations, including:

- Pest Animal Controller
- Weed Controller

Individuals in these roles work under general direction and participate in strategic invasive species management practices, prepare for management programs, complete and assess management programs, carry out weed management programs that require chemical spraying, maintain required records.

This course is an entry level Environmental Pest Management Qualification encompassing numerous hands on industry specific, field orientated practical activities.

OVERVIEW

This course is delivered in a face to face workshop and industry field placement format incorporating knowledge-based theory assessment and field practical assessment activities conducted over a day depending on the knowledge skill and competency of participants.
